It is with great pleasure and pride that I present this annual report to showcase our progress in terms of various activities & achievements made during this academic year.

ACADEMICS

Our achievements in Academics is a true reflection of the diligence and sincere efforts of our students in the CBSE examinations. The school secured 100% results in Std X and XII Board Examination for the Academic Year 2021-2022.

Of 156 students who registered for the AISSE, 23 secured A1 in all subjects, 147 secured distinction and 9 students got first class. 72 students secured A1 in English, 15 in Malayalam, 10 in Sanskrit and 18 in Hindi, 40 in Mathematics, 85 in Science and 62 in Social Science.
