MILESTONES OF ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Our students once again made the school proud by achieving outstanding results in both the Secondary School Examination (SSE) and the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE), reflecting their commitment, perseverance, and pursuit of excellence.

In the Class X (SSE) examination, all 158 students who appeared brought glory to the institution by securing 100% results. Of these, 153 students secured Distinction and 5 obtained First Class. It is commendable that 26 students achieved A1 grades in all subjects with AI, while 20 students secured A1 without AI , in all subjects.

Equally commendable were the results of Class XII (SSCE). Out of 144 students who appeared, 137 secured Distinction, upholding the school’s legacy of academic excellence. An impressive 37 students achieved A1 grades in all subjects with AI, while 23 students obtained A1 without AI .

These exceptional results are a reflection of our students’ dedication, the tireless efforts of our teachers, and the constant encouragement and support from the management and parents , together making Bhavan’s Adarsha Vidyalaya a pioneer in learning and success.

The Atal Tinkering Lab nurtures creativity, curiosity, and a problem-solving mindset among students of Classes VI to X through hands-on STEM learning. Students explore design thinking, basic electronics, and digital modelling while

developing prototypes and simulations that connect science and technology to real-world applications.

SPECIAL EDUCATION AND STUDENT WELLNESS CENTRE

The team of Special Educators functions effectively, catering to 67 students who require additional academic support under the guidance of three specially trained teachers and two professional counsellors. The school counsellors play a vital role in promoting students' overall well-being by conducting awareness sessions, arranging individual interactions, and recommending therapies wherever necessary. Their dedicated efforts ensure continuous support for the mental health and emotional well-being of all students and teachers.

SMART PRACTICES

The school continually adopts effective methods that inspire purposeful learning and responsible action. Each initiative is thoughtfully designed to develop life skills, strengthen values, and build social awareness among students. Bhavan's Adarsha Vidyalaya has introduced several innovative initiatives to foster holistic development among students. Harithahstham, part of Van Mahotsav, encouraged students to plant saplings at home and in school, nurturing environmental awareness and responsibility. The "I Create, I Learn" programme engaged students in designing educational models using simple materials, enhancing creativity and problem-solving skills. To boost communication, the Spoken English Initiative by the PTA provides interactive weekly sessions, while the Zero Period – A Journey Through Words and Wonder promotes reading, journal writing, and language fluency across all classes. Health awareness was addressed through the Sugar Board and Oil Board Projects, highlighting moderation and healthy habits. Students also showcase their talents in Talent Symphony, and Class Cultural Day offers opportunities for every student to perform, fostering confidence, creativity, and stage experience.

LEARNING BEYOND CLASSROOMS – EDUCATIONAL TOURS

Students were taken to destinations like **Lulu Mall** , **Chittilapilly Square**, Science Park etc providing opportunities to explore new environments, appreciate nature, and enhance creativity, critical thinking, and personal growth beyond the

classroom. A group of 30 students from classes 8,9&11 and two teachers attended a residential camp at the Bhavan's Nature Adventure Centre (BNAC), Mumbai—a distinguished unit of the Bhavan's fraternity and an official partner of the United Nations Decade on Biodiversity. The camp's thoughtfully designed programmes, featuring activities such as rock climbing, rappelling, zip-lining, the commando net, and the Burma bridge, along with skill-based sessions on map reading, pond ecology, renewable energy, organic composting, and biodiversity awareness, nurtured leadership, teamwork, environmental sensitivity, and personal growth among the participants. Evening engagements like campfires, storytelling, open mic sessions, and reflection circles added warmth and inspiration to the learning experience.

PARTNERS IN PROGRESS – PTA ENDEAVOURS

The PTA of our school continues to extend wholehearted support to all school initiatives. They honoured students who secured A1 grades in the SSE and SSCE examinations and contributed towards the conveyance expenses of nine students who represented the school at the National Sports Meet held at Varanasi. Communicative English sessions are conducted every Thursday to enhance students' language proficiency, alongside various awareness sessions on relevant topics. The PTA also sponsored payasam for all students during the Onam celebrations, reflecting their steadfast commitment to student welfare and holistic development.

The school's alumni, as goodwill ambassadors and resource persons, continue to play an active role in supporting various school initiatives. A friendly football match was organised, strengthening bonds and reflecting the enduring Bhavan's spirit.
